

How can I claim back tax?

If you give by envelope we will automatically keep a record of your giving so that at the end of the financial year we are able to send you a letter confirming the amount given. This letter can then be forwarded to your accountant or used in your personal tax return.

If you give by automatic payment or internet banking, we are only able to keep a record if you have included a parish-issued Giving number in your transaction details. Please contact the office to be given this Giving number, which allows your giving to be as close to anonymous as possible.

Individuals can claim a third of the donation back as a tax rebate, up to a maximum claim equal to their annual taxable income. If you would like to donate your rebate back to the parish you should complete the last section of the claim form to transfer the refund to IRD number 10-686-229 which is St Aidan's number.

How can I give?

There are several ways you can give:

1. Automatic Payment

This is when an automatic transfer of money is made from your bank account to ours every week/month/quarter. An automatic payment can be set up by the account holder via their internet banking connection or at a bank branch using our bank details which are: 06-0257-0052666-13. We can issue you with a giving number to quote where you are required to enter 'particulars to appear on the recipients bank statement' which allows us to issue you with a receipt in April for tax purposes.

This is our preferred option as it enables us to forecast our income and plan expenditure wisely.

2. Envelope giving

If your giving varies each week, this would be the best option for you. Upon request you are allocated a 'giving number' and a set of envelopes. You can then give anonymously by placing your envelope in the collection.

3. Cash donations

Putting cash in the offering during a service.

4. One-off donation

This is simply a one-off donation, perhaps to mark a special occasion.

5. Internet Banking

An electronic transfer can be made through online banking using our bank account details which are: 06-0257-0052666-013. We can issue you with a Giving number to quote in your transaction which allows us to issue you with a receipt in April for tax refund purposes. Contact the office for more details.
