Re.cognition



Over seven nights, in the week after Easter, Holy Trinity Cathedral will host an interactive art installation called re.cognition.

This will be a public event which invites visitors to engage in the Easter story, focusing on the resurrection narratives. Visitors will begin in the nave and journey across the entire cathedral site. Stations will engage different senses, pose questions for reflection and invite a deepening of faith. In order to make this happen the cathedral need volunteers. There are lots of ways people could assist: by working with station curators in the construction of props, in setting up and taking down their station, or by being present over the course of the installation as poets, hosts or offering hospitality.
