Curtain Call

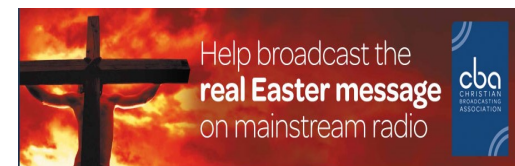
