No Physical Church Yet But...

Some features of church life will be able to begin and others to continue. Staff are now allowed to return to the office, gatherings of up to 10 people are able to take place and Wednesday and Sunday worship will continue online. This is possible while adhering to public health measures - high personal hygiene, physical distancing of 1 metre, meeting together for no longer than 2 hours, contact tracing.

The church office will be open from Monday 18th May, again following public health advice. If you need to come to church please be prepared to follow the protocols that will be in place.
