In 1905 members of the future parish of St Aidan's raised the necessary funds to establish our church.

The Endowment Trust, which was established in 2014, will help secure the financial future of St Aidan's in good times and bad.

How will the Endowment Trust do that?

The cost of the wide range of services which St Aidan's provides to the community keeps increasing. Funds received by the Endowment Trust will be secured and invested for the future and the income from those funds will help offset the increased demands on the Church's financial resources.

Who will manage the funds?

The Trustee is The General Trust Board of the Anglican Diocese of Auckland who will manage the secure investment of the capital fund and the distribution of the income.
