## Make a Better Fitting Mask

Always start with clean hands! Fold  
the surgical mask in half lengthwise,  
so the bottom and top edges are  
together, outside outwards.

Take one ear loop and make a knot  
as close as possible to the corners of  
the mask; repeat on the other side.

Open out and fold the middle into a  
V on the inside, tuck in as necessary.

For arthritic fingers, skip the knots  
and form a V with the side edges of  
the mask and staple in place.
