We have also reintroduced wine in the common cup, or grape juice in individual cups, during Communion for those who would like to partake.

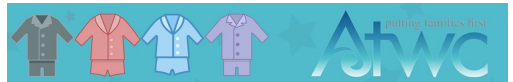
If you prefer not to do so just yet you are welcome to continue receiving bread only, and you are always welcome to simply come forward for a blessing if you prefer not to receive Communion.
