Next on 29th October, 7pm to 8pm.

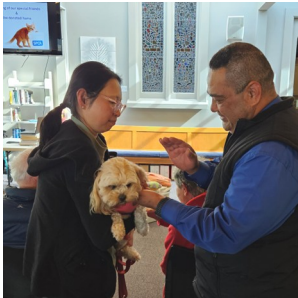


Pastoral Letter

Pet Service

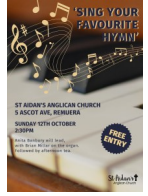
Thank you to everyone who attended our St Francis' Day Pet Service last Sunday and donated items for the SPCA.
